## THE QUESTION THAT CHANGES EVERYTHING

***“Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word.” – Luke 1:38***

That “yes” cost her comfort, reputation, and certainty. But God trusted her because she wouldn’t resist His will. God told Abraham to leave everything familiar:

***“Get out of your country... to a land that I will show you.” – Genesis 12:1***

No map, no explanation, just instruction and later, God tested him again:

***“Take now your son... and offer him there as a burnt offering.” – Genesis 22:2***

Why would God make such a demand? Because trust is proven by obedience under pressure. God does not commit His will to curiosity – He commits it to trustworthiness.

So, pause and ask yourself, *If God gave me a divine instruction today, will I obey immediately, or will I hesitate?*

## THE TRAITS GOD TRUSTS

*“God is not looking for perfect people, He is looking for yielded people.”*

Trust with God is not about gifting - it is about **posture**. Here are the traits that make a man trustworthy in God’s sight:

### 1. Obedience Without Delay

Delayed obedience is disguised disobedience. Abraham didn’t argue, he moved.

*“So Abraham departed as the Lord had spoken to him.” –  
Genesis 12:4*

God trusts those who act when He speaks.

### 2. Surrendered Will

Jesus Christ, at His most intense moment, prayed:

*“Nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.” – Luke 22:42*

If Jesus had to surrender His will, what makes us think we won’t? God’s will only flows through people who have laid down their own.

### 3. Faith Without Full Clarity

*“For we walk by faith, not by sight.” – 2 Corinthians 5:7*

God will not always explain Himself. If He did, it wouldn’t require trust.

### 4. Sensitivity to God’s Voice

Before Samuel spoke to nations, he learned to respond:

*“Speak, Lord, for Your servant hears.” – 1 Samuel 3:10*

Trustworthy people are not just busy – they are **attentive**.

### 5. Faithfulness in Secret

*“He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much.” –  
Luke 16:10*

God watches what you do when no one is watching. Private faithfulness qualifies you for public assignments. God does not entrust His will to the most talented, He entrusts it to the most dependable.

## **BECOMING A MAN GOD CAN TRUST**

*“If God cannot trust you, He will pass you.”*

That may sound hard - but it is truth. In Ezekiel, God said:

***“I sought for a man... but I found no one.” – Ezekiel 22:30***

Imagine heaven searching and finding no one qualified. Don't let that be you. Here's how to position yourself:

### **1. Obey the Last Instruction God Gave You**

Many are waiting for new direction while ignoring the last one.

***“If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land.” – Isaiah 1:19***

### **2. Build a Strong Prayer Life**

Prayer aligns your heart with God's will.

***“Your kingdom come. Your will be done...” – Matthew 6:10***

### **3. Crucify Self Daily**

***“If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself...” – Luke 9:23***

You cannot carry God's will and your ego at the same time.

### **4. Stay Rooted in God's Word**

***“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.” – Psalm 119:105***

God's will never contradicts His Word.

### **5. Embrace Process, Not Just Promise**

Even David was anointed king long before he sat on the throne.

***“Though it tarries, wait for it...” – Habakkuk 2:3***

Trust is built in the waiting seasons.

## **FINAL CHARGE**

*“God is not looking for people to impress - He is looking for people to entrust.”*

Your prayer should change today. Not just “Lord, show me Your will...” but “Lord, make me trustworthy enough to carry it.”

Because when God finds a man He can trust, He releases purpose, power, and destiny through that man.

So the question remains, *can God trust you with His will?*
